They arrived at an all -inclusive theme called: **Women about Woman, A BROAD Introspective Retrospective.**

Women's History Month in March celebrates women's significant contributions in all fields of endeavors, not the least of which are the creative arts. For too long, women have been rendered "invisible" by their absence in the traditional recording of history. As journalist Phoebe Hoban states in her recent *ARTnews* article, *The Feminist Evolution*, "Museums are exhibiting an increased sensitivity to collecting and presenting works by womenbut true gender equality... remains elusive".

From an open call to women artists, the curators selected work in a variety of media, addressing a fascinating range of personal issues. While many regional artist studio visits were made to select particular works to create the exhibit's conversation, images arrived from artists throughout the country including California, Florida, PA, NJ, CT and upstate NY.

The exhibition will represent 20 women artists and will include sculptures, paintings, collages, assemblage with found objects, book art, fiber and mixed media.
